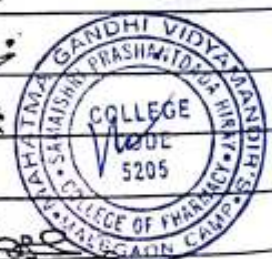

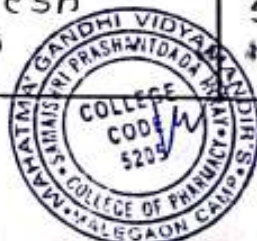

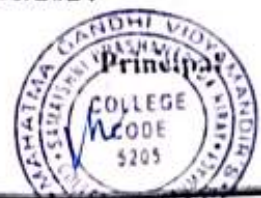
**Lecture on Beti Padhao Beti Bachao**

**Evaluation of Pharmacokinetic Parameter of Naphthol compound**

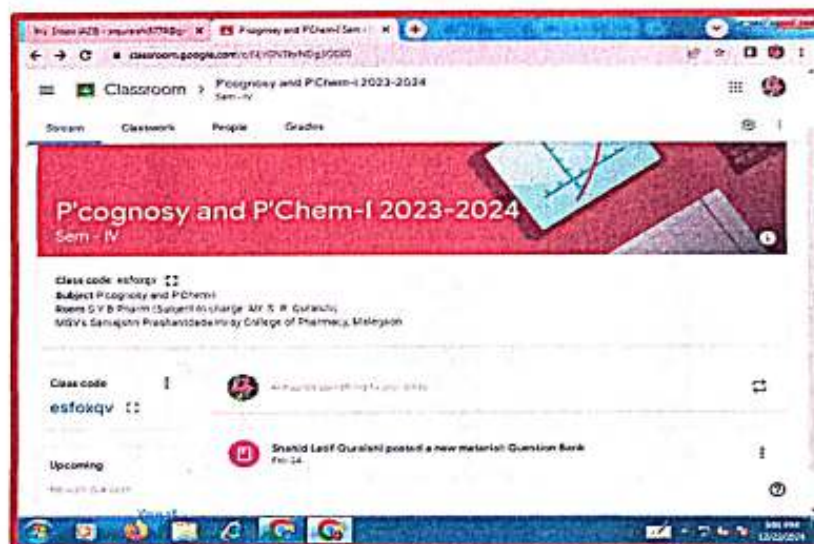
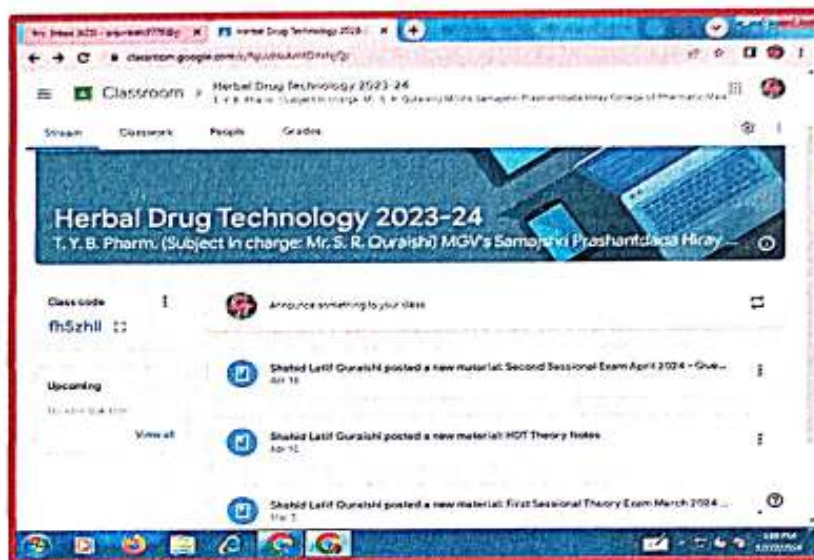
